#### Diamond Dreams Over Forty Baseball League Coronavirus Guidelines/Rules and Risk Warning:

- IF ANY OF THE GUIDELINES/RULES BELOW ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE TO ANY INDIVIDUAL, you will not be allowed to play in the Diamond Dreams Over Forty Baseball League for 2023.
   It is suggested that seniors or others with compromised immune systems or other co-morbidity Conditions not participate in or attend practices or games this season due to risk of infection.
  - 2. Do not enter the baseball complex (field, dugouts, bleachers, and areas surrounding the field or bleachers) if you are exhibiting any signs of illness such as sneezing, coughing, sniffles, have fever, or do not feel well. If you are repeatedly sneezing or coughing, you may be asked to immediately leave the premises. Spitting is discouraged around other players & in the dugout.
  - Hand sanitizer will be required in each team's dugout. Players will be responsible for providing hand and equipment sanitizers for themselves for usage throughout the game.
  - 4. Players are highly encouraged to use their own helmets and bats, however if multiple players use the helmets & bats, they should be wiped down or sprayed with a sanitizer or decontaminant after each use to prevent infection risk.
  - 5. Players are NOT required to wear PPE on the field during game play, including catchers and batters. Even though this is NOT required, it is highly recommended, but it is up to each INDIVIDUAL. to decide whether or not they wear PPE during on-field game play...
  - All players, staff, and participants (umpires & scorekeepers) should wear PPE such as face masks, whenever they are not on the field of play (when in the dugouts or off the field outside the fair/foul lines)
  - 7. NO HANDSHAKES OR TOUCHING OF ANY KIND WILL TAKE PLACE BETWEEN PLAYERS
    BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER COMPLETION OF GAMES. Just waive and congratulate fellow players & managers.
  - 8. All players, staff, and spectators should practice responsible social distancing by remaining at least 6 ft apart whenever possible. This can include having some players sit outside of the dugout when distancing is not possible for all players in the dugout.
  - SPECTATORS will be required to wear PPE (face coverings/masks and disposable gloves) and must abide by a strict 6 ft separation, as well as bringing their own seating. NO SPECTATORS will be allowed to sit in the stands or bleachers.
  - 10. No gatherings will take place in the ball parks while entering, exiting, or moving about. This includes in the parking lot after games. THERE may NOT BE ANY PUBLIC RESTROOMS PROVIDED.
